Maryland This Indenture made this Twenty sixth day of January
 in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred Forty eight and nine
 Between Henry Welsh of Ann Arundel County in the Province afo. Gentleman
 of the one Part and Mary Higgins of the County and Province afo. Widow
 of the other Part Witnesseth That Whereas a Marriage is intended
 by Gods Permission to be shortly solemnized Between the said Parties And
 Whereas the said Mary Higgins in her own Right stands Possessed of
 and Interested in several Messuages Lands Tenements Household
 Furniture Goods and Chattels and among others of the Five following
 Negroes to wit Ann, Eleanor, Lucy, Mary and David Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth That for and in Consideration of the said Intended Marriage
 and of the Sum of five Shillings Sterling Money of Great Britain
