Returnable to the next Provincial Court whereby the said John
Gaspaway shall and may Demand against the said Henry
Ridgely one third Part of all that Tract or Parcell of Land
called Ridgely's Addition lying in Prince Georges Containing One
hundred Acres of Land by such Name or Names Quantity ~~and~~ Quanti-
ties Quality or Qualities Content or Number of Acres as shall be
thought fit and Requisite to which Writ or Writs the said Henry
Ridgely shall appear in Proper Person and shall Vouch over to
Warranty the Common Vouches and the Common Vouches shall
appear and Impare and afterwards shall make Default whereby
one or more Recovery or Recoverys Judgment or Judgments may
be had and given for the said John Gaspaway for Recovery of the
Land and Premises as afo. against the said Henry Ridgely and
for the said Henry Ridgely to Recover over in Value against the
Common Vouches according to the form of Common Recovery
in such Cases used and it is further Covenanted Granted and
Agreed by and Between the Parties to these Presents and the
True Intent and meaning of the Parties to these Presents
