he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every Part and Part
thereof doth fully clearly and Absolutely Acquit Exonerate and
Discharge the said Samuel Ogle his Executors and Administra-
tors by these Presents and for divers other good Causes and
Considerations him thereunto moving he the said Henry Ridgely
hath granted Bargained Sold Aliened Enfoffed and
Confirmed and by these Presents doth Grant Bargain Sell
Alien Enfoffe and Confirm unto the said Samuel Ogle one
third Part of all that Tract of Land called Larkins Forest
lying in Prince Georges County on the West side of Potomac
