This Indenture made this Tenth Day of August  
in the Year of our Lord Christ One Thousand seven Hundred  
and forty nine Between Sidney George of Cecil County  
in the Province of Maryland Gentleman of the one Part and  
Joseph Wood of the same County Gentleman of the other  
Part Where as the afo. Sidney George in May Term last  
past did Commence Prosecute and bring one Writ of Entry  
Sur Disseizin against the same Joseph Wood thereby Demand-  
ing all that Tract or Parcell of Plantable Land lying in  
Cecil County afo. being part of a Tract of Land Originally  
granted to Augustme Herman called the Three Bohemian  
Sisters the same part thereof which by the last Will and Testament  
of the same Augustme Herman was given and Devided to his  
Daughter Francina Grand Mother of the same Joseph Wood  
being the Uppermost Neck of the same Land on the East of the  
same Original Tract Running from Lord George's Court  
Road mentioned in the same Will along the Back River Run to  
Elk River Road and then along the said Elk River Road  
Northerly till it meets with the same Court Road again  
Containing Twelve Hundred and Sixty Acres of Land  
more or less with the Appurtenances thereunto belonging
