Confirm unto him the said Robert North his heirs and  
assigns for ever all that Tract or parcell of Land called  
part of a Green Spring Tavern lying in Baltimore C<sup>t</sup>y  
aforesaid and beginning at two bound<sup>d</sup> White Oaks being  
the beginning Trees of the Original Tract and running  
thence East twenty degrees then North eleven and a quarter degrees  
East ten degrees then West eighty seven degrees then West North
