Containing four Thousand two hundred and Sixty nine Acres or thereabouts And
Whereas the said Hugh Parker is Indebted unto the said Jeremiah Warden the sum
of Nine hundred & fifty five Pounds Seven Shillings and Five Pence Pennsylvania
Currency and unto the said Samuel Neave the sum of five hundred and fifty two pounds
fifteen Shillings and Seven pence like Currency besides One hundred and thirty three
Pounds thirteen Shillings and four pence of the Currency also unto Levy and Banks
of the said City of Philadelphia Merchant and three hundred and ninety one Pounds
Eighteen Shillings and one penny of the Currency aforesaid unto John Reynell of the said
City of Philadelphia Merchant which Debts the said Hugh Parker is desirous to pay
