over unto the said William Cumming the Younger his Heirs Exrs Adms (except the
said Mortgage of the said Philip Hammond that is to be redeemed) as his own proper
Lands and Tenements Goods and Chattels upon special Trust and Confidence & Reveren-
-ces and the true Intent and Purpose that the said William Cumming the Younger
his Heirs Exrs Adms or Assigns or his Attorney or some or one of them shall and will
