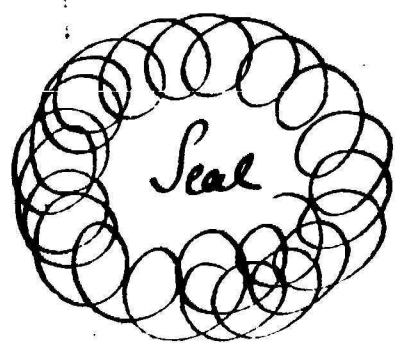

of you the said Edmund Jennings do (by Virtue of the Powers given in the Letters
Patent from King Charles the first to Cecilius Baron of Baltimore his Heirs and
Assignes of the said Province of Maryland) by these Presents constitute and appoint
you the said Edmund Jennings Secretary of the said Province of Maryland with full
Powers and Authority to you the said Edmund Jennings to execute the said
Office of Secretary and to do and perform all other Acts usually done by the
(former)
