Planter of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Collings for and in Consideration of the Sum of Sixty Pounds Current Money of the Province of Maryland to him in hand paid by the said Andrew Jamehill before the sealing and delivery of these Presents whereof the said Thomas Collings doth hereby acknowledge him to be therewith fully Satisfied Contented and paid and thereof and of every part thereof doth acquit and Discharge Andrew Jamehill his Heirs Executors Administrators and assigns and hath given granted ^{aliened} Bargained Sold and Confirmed and by these Presents doth fully justly and Absolutely Bargain Sell and Confirm unto the said Andrew Jamehill All that Parcel of Land called Pomfretfields being part of a Tract of Land called Ninestoroom Situate lying and being in St. Marys County Beginning at a Bounded Tree standing by a Run formerly called St. Peters Run it being the East Bounded Tree of a Tract of Land called Downham formerly Surveyed for Edward Clark now in the Possession of John Ford and Running thence East Ninety four Perches to a Bounded Oak being also a Bounded Tree of the afo. Tract of Land thence North West Eighty Perches to a Bounded White Oak thence South West to the afo. St. Peters Run and with the said Run to the first Bounded Tree containing fortys even Acres be it more or less and that Parcel of Land called Pomfret being part of a Tract of Land of the same name lying adjoining to the afo. Tract of Land Beginning at a Bounded Tree standing by the afo. St. Peters Run and where the afo. Parcel of Land Ends and Running thence North East Eighty Perches to a Bounded White Oak being a Bounded Tree of the afo.
