This Indenture made this fourth day of October in the Year of our Lord Christ One Thousand seven hundred and forty nine Between Robert Hawkins of Queen Anne's County in the Province of Maryland Planter of the one part and Edmund Hawkins of the same County Planter and Jane his Wife of the other part Whereas the afo. Robert Hawkins at a Provincial Court here at the City of Annapolis for the Province of Maryland on the third Tuesday of October in the Year aforesaid One Thousand seven hundred and forty eight did commence and prosecute against the same Edmund and Jane his Wife one Suit of Entry and Ejectment thereby demanding against the same Edmund and Jane all that Tract or Parcel of Land called Conquest Spring and being in Queen Anne's County afo. Beginning at a marked cedar marked with Twelve Notches three on every side standing on the South East and by East line of a Parcel of Land formerly laid out for Col. Henry Coursey called Coursey's Point and running with the said Land South East by East four hundred Perches to a marked Cedar (Tree)
