


86 This Indenture made this fifth Day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty one Between William Howard of Charles County Gentleman of the one part and Thomas Sparrow of the City of Annapolis of the other part Whereas it was agreed by and between the Partys herein to that for Warming Docking Destroying and Extinguishing all Estate tail and all Recoveries or Remainder thereupon Expectant or Depending of and in all that part or parcel of a Tract of Land called the three Brothers in Charles County Beginning at a Dounded White Oak the third Bounder of the said Tract called the three Brothers and running thence South four Degrees East one hundred and thirty eight Leches to a Dounded Black Oak standing on a Plain then West and by North one Degree Northwesterly three hundred and twenty four
