his Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns against him the said Richard Tuckston his Heirs
and Assigns and against all and all manner of Persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for
ever Defend and the said Richard Tuckston ^{Doth} further Covenant Promise and Agree to and with the
said Michael Crager his Heirs and Assigns that he the said Richard Tuckston his Heirs Executors
Administrators or Assigns shall and will at the request and charge of him the said Michael
Crager his Heirs or Assigns Make acknowledge Suffer and Execute any Deed or Instrument of
