This Indenture made this 13th day of November in the Year of our Lord God One Thousand seven hundred fifty and one Between Thomas Morris Grandson and Heir of Robert Morris of Annapolis County Deceased on the one part and Charles Canoll of Annapolis on the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Morris for and in Consideration of the sum of eight Pounds Current Money of Maryland to him in hand paid at and before the enrolling and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted Bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these Presents Doth give grant Bargain sell alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto him the said Charles Canoll All that Tract or Parcel of Land called Hickory Ridge in Baltimore County on Patuxent River containing Fifty Acres formerly Granted unto Robert Morris Grand-Father of him the said Thomas Morris together with all the Woods Underwoods Buildings and Appurtenances whatsoever in or upon the said Tract of Land called Hickory Ridge being belonging and appertaining To have and to hold unto him the said Charles Canoll his Heirs and Assigns forever and the said Thomas Morris doth Covenant and Agree with him the said Charles Canoll his Heirs and Assigns for ever shall and may have hold and Enjoy the said Fifty Acres of Land called Hickory Ridge with its appurtenances Warranted and Defended as well against him the said Thomas Morris as any other Person or Persons from by or under him or his said Grand-Father Robert Morris claiming or to claim In Witness whereof the said Party to these Presents have Interchangeably put their hands and Seals the Day and Year first above Written
