

Given at London under our hand and great Seal at Arms this Seventeenth day of March in the Twenty sixth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the Second and in the Second Year of our Dominion over the said Province and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and fifty three.
