Frederick County and Province a Gentleman of the one part and Charles Graham of
Calvert County and John Cooke Esq^r of Prince Georges County both of the Province
of the other part Witnesseth that Whereas William Cumming stands Justly
Indebted unto John Wardrop and Charles Graham in Company Merchants in Calvert
County by Bond in the Penal sum of four hundred ninety seven Pound one
Shilling and nine Pence Sterling Money of Great Britain in which Bond the said
William Cumming is Nominated and Called William Cumming Jun^r jointly and
severally with William Cumming Esq^r of the City of Annapolis now deceased as
by the said Bond dated the fourth day of March in the Year of our Lord Seventeen
hundred and fifty reference being thereto had may more fully appear for the
Recovery of which said Debt due as aforesaid the said John Wardrop and Charles
Graham have brought their Action in the Provincial against the said William
Cumming above mentioned as by reference being had to the Proceedings of the said
