Dingan Wilson and Mary Wilson his Wife do for themselves their or either of their  
Heirs Ex<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>s and Assigns by these Presents Promise Covenant and Agree to and  
with the said John Eversfield his Heirs and Assigns in manner following that is —  
to say. That the Aforesaid Tract of Land called Thinsale and part of a Tract called —  
Beane's Landing thereto Adjoining with their respective Appurtenances within the  
Bounds Courses and Distances aforesaid are not Encumbered or Encumbered either  
in Title of Estate Certainty of Bounds or otherwise But are clear and free from all  
Ancienter Surveys, Prior Titles, Bargains Sales Mortgages (excepting that specified  
to John Eversfield Jun<sup>r</sup> paid off and discharged by the Revd John Eversfield) —  
Entails, Joyners, Dowers, Loan Office Debts or Securities Judgments Executions —  
Arrearages of Rents and from all Incumbrances whatsoever and that they the  
said Dingan Wilson and Mary his Wife have in them good Right Power and —  
Authority to Grant Bargain Sell and make over in Fee Simple the said Tract of  
Land called Thinsale and that part of a Tract thereto Adjacent called Beanes —  
Landing with their Appurtenances unto him the said John Eversfield his Heirs  
Assigns for ever, and that he the said John Eversfield his Heirs and Assigns shall  
and may for ever hereafter Peaceably and Quietly Enjoy the said Lands and  
Premises with their Appurtenances from all Suits Molestation or Disturbance —  
whatsoever from the said Dingan Wilson and Mary his Wife their or either of

or either of them or of and from any other Person or Persons whatsoever and  
that they the said Dingan Wilson and Mary his Wife their and either of their  
Heirs Ex<sup>r</sup> and Adm<sup>r</sup>s shall and will Warrant and Defend the saids  
Land and Premises with their respective Appurtenances within the Bounds —  
Courses and Distances aforesaid against all Persons Claims and Incumbrances —  
whatsoever (Rents to the Proprietor hereafter becoming due Excepted and foregoed)  
And lastly will any time do make Execute Seal and Acknowledge any other  
Deed or Instrument of Writing unto him the said John Eversfield his Heirs or  
Assigns for the more sure perfect and absolute making over and confirming the  
said Lands and Premises with their respective Appurtenances unto him the said  
John Eversfield his Heirs or Assigns such as by him or those claiming under
