 John Chalmers for and in Consideration of the <sup>said</sup> Sum of One Hundred and Twenty  
 Pounds Doth by these presents Give Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release make over  
 and Confirm unto him the Said Charles Carrolle All his Estate Right Title  
 Interest Claim and Demand of in or to the Said One Hundred Acres of Land  
 Called Bear Den Situate Lying and being in Frederick County as aforesaid  
 Together with all Profits and Advantages or thereto in any wise belonging or  
 Appertaining To have and to hold unto him the Said Charles Carrolle his  
 Heirs and Assigns for ever and the Said John Chalmers doth for himself and his  
 Heirs Covenant and Agree that he the Said Charles his Heirs and Assigns for ever shall  
 and may quietly and peaceably Have hold and Enjoy the Said Land Called Bear Den  
 as well against him the Said John Chalmers as against all manner of Person or  
 Claims whatsoever In Witness whereof the Said parties to these presents have  
 Interchangeably Set their Hands & Seals the day and Year first above written.
