This Indenture made this 25th day of April in the year of Our
Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and fifty five between Joshua
Beall of Prince Georges County Planter of the one part and Susannah Brooke
now the Wife of Henry Brooke Mariner but lately the Wife and Heiress
of Nunian Beall Mariner of the other part. Whereas Charles Beall
late of the said Prince Georges County Planter by his Testament and
last Will amongst other things devised unto his two Sons
the said Nunian and Joshua Beall all that Tract of Land
belonging to him called Darby lying in Dorset County on the Eastern
Shore near the Head of Great Choptank to be Equally Divided between
them if they sell it and if not the said Nunian to have the southside
of a Branch of Wallace's Creek running through the said Land
and the said Joshua to have all on the North side of the said
Branch to them and their Heirs and at their Decease to be
as by the said Testament and last Will relation being thereunto
