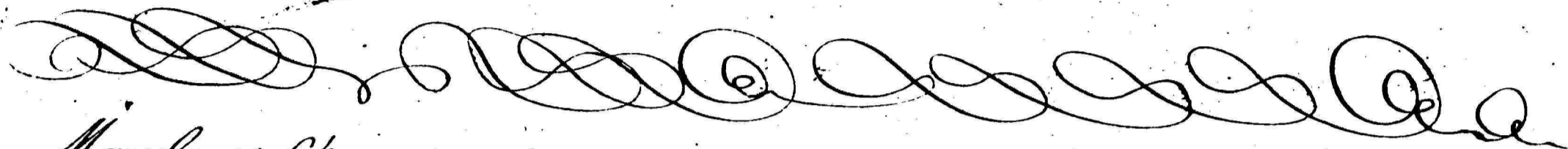

This Indenture made the fourth Day of April in the Year of Our Lord God One Thousand Seven hundred and fifty five between Philemon Daway and Elizth Ridgely of Ann Arundell County of the one part and James Brooke Jun^r of Frederick County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Philemon Daway and Elizth Ridgely for and in Consideration of the Sum of Six pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain to them in hand paid by the said James Brooke the Receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted Bargained sold and Confirmed and by these Presents they the said Philemon Daway and Elizth Ridgely doth for themselves and their Heirs Give Grant Bargain Sell and Confirm unto the said James Brooke his Heirs and Assignes for Ever a Certain Parcel a part of a Tract of Land called Blanco lying on the Branches of Patuxent River commonly called Snowden's River Beginning at large Stone Marked with these Letters following B. P. D. R. S. lying on the Branch of the up. River on the West Side thereof partly on the Water Near the Mouth of a small Glard and Running thence North Fifty three Degrees West thirty two perches South Eighty seven Degrees West thirty two Perches North twenty two Degrees West Eighty four Perches North ten Degrees East Forty two Perches to the End of the Eleventh Course of the Oxenway of the said Land then with the Out lines of the said Land West One hundred Perches to the End of the twelfth Course of the Oxenway of the said Oxenway of then East two hundred Perches South ten Degrees East thirty four Perches South Sixty four Degrees East Sixty six Perches South thirty two Degrees East Fifty perches North Sixty seven and one half Degrees East thirty three perches

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
