And We do hereby further empower you the said George Stewart to receive all Perquisites Fees and Advantages whatsoever to the said Office of Deputy Secretary belonging or in anywise appertaining in a full and ample Manner as any person or Persons hitherto have held or ought to have hold and enjoy the same To have hold Exercise and enjoy the said office and to take and receive all such fees Perquisites and Advantages as of unto you the said George Stewart during Our Will and Pleasure Witness Our trusty and Well beloved Horatio Sharpe Esquire Lieutenant General and Chief Governor of Our said Province of Maryland This 20.
