And at the same Time same Elizabeth the Wife of
the said Richard Snowden and she being Examined privately
and out of the hearing of her said Husband Declareth that
she releaseth her Right of Dower to the Land and Premises
within mentioned and that she maketh the same Acknowledgment
willingly and Freely and without being Intimidated by fears
threats or ill Usage of her said Husband or for fear of his displeasure
according to the Act of Assembly before mentioned
