 thirty fifth Year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Charles Absolute Lord and
 Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c An
 in the Year of our Lord God One Thousand seven hundred forty and nine Between Thomas
 Jones of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland Merchant of the first Part Richard
 Waters of the County and Province of Maryland Merchant of the second Part and John
 Williams of the County and Province afo^r Merchant of the third Part Witnesseth
 that the said Thomas Jones for the Docking Baring and Cutting off all Estates Tail
 and Remainders in Tail of and in the Mesuage Tenement Lands and Hereditaments
 herein after mentioned and for the Setting and Apuring of the same to and for the Uses
 Intents and Purposes herein after Limited Expresses and Declared and in Consideration
 of five Shillings to him in hand paid by the said Richard Waters the Receipt whereof
 hereby acknowledged and for divers other good Causes and Considerations him the
 said Thomas Jones in this behalf moving hath granted Bargained and Sold
 Released and Confirmed and by these Presents Doth Grant Bargain and Sell Release
 and Confirm unto the said Richard Waters and to his Heirs and Assigns for ever All that
 Tract of Land called Little Bolton lying in Somerset County on the South side of
 Annamesia River and Bounded as followeth Beginning at the Mouth of on the
 Western side of a Creek Issuing out of Annamesia River afo^r called by the Name of Ha in
 Creek at the Easternmost End of a Hammock called Eagle Point thence up and with
 the said Creek South thirty degrees Easterly Seventy two Perches thence North Sixty four
 Degrees Easterly forty five Perches thence South Sixty seven Degrees Easterly twenty one
 Perches thence South forty nine Degrees Easterly forty Perches thence South twenty four
 Degrees Easterly thirty two Perches thence South twenty Degrees Easterly thirty four
 Perches thence South twenty four Degrees Easterly twenty eight Perches thence South
 Eighty one Degrees Easterly twenty Perches thence South twenty four Degrees Westerly
 twenty one Perches thence South twenty three Perches thence South twenty seven degree
 Easterly forty eight Perches thence North Seventy four Degrees Easterly forty eight
