

This Indenture made the Eighteenth Day of August in the
 Fifth year of the Dominion of the right Hon. the Frederick absolute
 Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Annapolis Lord Baron
 of Baltimore &c. and in the years of our Lord God one Thousand Seven
 hundred and fifty and five Between John Cain son of Will. Cain
 late of Baltimore County of the one part and John More of Baltimore
 Town in the County of Baltimore in the Province of Maryland
 of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the
 Sum of fifty pounds Current money of Maryland to him the said
 John Cain in hand paid by the aforesaid John More before the making
 and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said John
 Cain do hereby acknowledge and thereof do acquit Release and
 Discharge the said John More his Heirs &c. and administ.
 Executors by these presents to the said John Cain ^{heath} granted
 bargained and sold Alien Release and Confirmed and by these
 Presents doth Grant bargain and sell Alien Release and Confirmed
 unto the said John More his Heirs and Assigns forever all
 the & state Right Title Interest Claim property and Demand
 whatsoever which to the said John Cain hath unto tract
 or parcel of Land lying and being in Baltimore County and
 upon the south side of Gun powder River and upon the south
 side of branch of the said River commonly called Back River
 beginning at a bounded white stake on a Lovell's near the top
 of branch then running up the branch West thirty perches
 to a bounded red stake on the aforesaid Lovell's near the said
 Creek then running into the woods South five hundred
 thirty four perches parallel with a parcel of Land
 belonging to Rich. Venly of the aforesaid County planter then
 running East thirty perches terminating to the East by Land
 call Spring neck then running with a direct line to
 the first boundaries containing one hundred Aeres more or
 less Surveyed in the year sixteen hundred and eighty
 three by Thomas Richardson and call by the name
 Richardsons plains together with all houses orchards
 and improvements whatsoever to have and to hold the
 aforesaid parcel of Land with the rights members and appurte-
 nances unto the said John More and his Heirs and Assigns forever
 to the only proper use and behoof the said John More and
