Peterkin I ever had now have or which I my Heirs Ex. & Adm. shall or may have Claim Challenge or Demand for or by Reasons or means of any Act matter Cause or thing from the beginning of the World to the day of the date of these Presents and particularly of and from one Obligation bearing date the twenty third day of June Anno Domini seventeen hundred and forty and three which was paid to me by the said Jam. Peterkin and a certain Charles Goldsborough in the Sum of one hundred and four Pounds six Shillings Sterling conditioned for the payment of fifty two Pounds eight Shillings Sterling and of and from the Judgment which was rendered on the said Bond against the said James in the Provincial Court and of and from all Executions which now are or hereafter shall Issue on the said Judgment In Witness whereof I hereto set my hand and Seal the 2 Day of May Anno Dom. 1750
