 doth acquit and discharge the said Henry
 Trueman son to the said Henry Trueman
 his heirs and assigns hath given granted Bargain
 sold aliened Enfeoffed confirmed and make over unto
 the said Henry Trueman son to the said Henry
 Trueman his heirs and assigns forever all that
 part of a Tract of Land called Buttington beginning
 at three willow Saplings standing on a small
 Branch that falleth into a Branch which ~~runneth~~
 divideth Prince Georges from Charles County
 that falleth into Swansons Creek Running thence
 south Twenty nine degrees East seven perches to
 the end of the sixth course of M^r Henry Trueman
 first purchase of part of said Tract as is of Record of conveyance
 bearing date December the first seventeen hundred and
 forty three it being a North Eighty Three degrees West Course
 of said purchase then with the said purchase reversed South
 Eighty Three degrees East twenty Eight Perches then with the
 said purchase reversed south seventy six degrees East Fifty
 Eight Perches then with the said purchase reversed South
 Seventy and one Quarter degrees East Fifty Four perches then with
 the said purchase East fifteen degrees North Twenty four perches
