 late of Ann Hundoll County Gentleman now Deceased of the one part &
 Charles Hammond - of Ann Hundoll County Esquire of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Charles Homewood for and in Consideration
 of the sum of five Shillings of Lawfull money of England to him in hand
 paid by the said Charles Hammond at or before the Enrolling & Delivering
 of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged Both
 by the said Charles Hammond and by these presents both bargain and sell
 unto the said Charles Hammond all that Tract or parcel of Land called
 Hixteen hundred and Ninety two Acres more or less and also all that Tract
 or parcel of Land lying in the County of Middlesex called Alcotts Triangle
 containing Seventy Acres more or less and also all that Tract or parcel
 of Land lying and being in the County of Middlesex called Hog Neck alias
 Danks containing Twenty Acres more or less and also all that Tract
 or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Middlesex called Bennets
 Park containing Eighty one Acres more or less and also all that Tract
 or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Middlesex called
 Pythons containing Sixty Acres more or less and also all that Tract or parcel of
 Land lying and being in the County of Middlesex called Homewoods parcel contain-
 ing sixty Acres more or less to have and to hold the said Lands
 Tenements Hereditaments and Appurtenances with the Appurtenances fully
 and sold unto the said Charles Hammond his Exors. Adors. and Assigns
 from the day next before the day of the date of these presents to and
 during unto the full end and term of one Whole Year from thence next
 ensuing and fully to be completed and ended to the intent and purpose
 that the said Charles Hammond may be the better enabled to receive and take
 or intended to be fully bargained and sold to him and his Assigns for
 and during the Natural Life of the said Charles Homewood in such
 full manner and form, as in and by One Indenture intended to bear
 date the Next day after the date of these presents, the same shall
 be granted released and conveyed In Witness Whereof the parties to
