Heirs and Successors to which Payments well & truly to be made
And Done we bind ourselves and each of us our and every of our
Heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally for the
Whole and in the whole firmly by these Presents sealed with our
Seals and dated this 1st Day of June Anno Domini 1756.

The Conditions of the above Obligation is such that if the said John
Bullen as one of the Commissioners of the Loan Office shall well and truly
Execute the several Powers and Authorities by him to be Done and Performed
According to the true Intent and meaning of an Act of Assembly Entituled an
Act for granting a Supply of forty Thousand Pound for his Majesty
Service and striking thirty four thousand and fifteen pounds said shillings
Thereof in Bills of Credit and raising a fund, or sinking the same that
Then the above Obligation is to be Paid or Eff'd to Remain in full force and
Virtue in Law
