month made between Nathurton Gay of the one part and Joseph Ennor  
party to the said presents of the other part the said Nathurton Gay did  
bargain sell Alien Infeoff and Confirm unto him the said Joseph Ennor  
his heirs and assigns two lotto of Land lying in Baltimore town in Baltimore  
County of no. Number sixty three and sixty four with all their appurtenances  
to the same appertaining the relation being the same as had which is now upon  
Record in Baltimore County Records may more fully and at large appear  
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Joseph Ennor for and in  
consideration of the sum of eighty pounds Sterling money of Great Britain  
to him in hand by the said Charles Carroll paid the full sum whereof the  
said Joseph Ennor doth hereby acknowledge hath and by these presents doth  
give grant bargain sell Alien Infeoff and Confirm unto him the said  
Charles Carroll his heirs and assigns all his right title property Interest  
Claim and demand of in and unto one of the said Lotto of Land known and  
distinguished by Number sixty three as aforesaid with all and singular the  
appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining so  
have and to hold the said Lotto of Land and premises with the  
appurtenances unto him the said Charles Carroll his heirs and assigns  
for ever and the said Joseph Ennor doth for himself his heirs Executors  
and Administrators further Covenant Grant and agree to and with the  
said Charles Carroll his heirs and assigns that he said Joseph Ennor  
the said bargained premises against all Manner of persons or persons
