Witnesseth that the said Jacob Morris for and in consideration of the full and just sum of forty
Pounds Current Money already to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and thereof and every part and parcel thereof doth hereby acquit and discharge the said
Jesper Hall Jun^r his Heirs Executors Administrators by these Presents he the said Jacob Morris
doth Give Grant Bargain sell Alien Enfeoff and confirm and by these Presents hath given
Granted Bargained sold Alien^d Enfeoffed and Confirmed unto him the said Jesper Hall Jun^r
his Heirs and Assigns forever Twenty Acres of Land being part of a Tract of Land called
Jacobs Lott Originally laid out for fifty Acres of Land thirty Acres of the said Tract being
already sold to Henry Rutter also all that Tract of Land called Majors Choice Originally
granted unto a certain John Thomas for the Quantity of one hundred and forty Acres of
(Land)
