 then and in such case this present Deed and every Clause Article Matter and thing therein
 contained to cease and to be void and of no Effect whatsoever as if the same had never been

 hundred and fifty Between Caleb Dorsey of Ann Arundell County Gentleman of the one Part and Uncle
 Unckles of Frederick County of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Caleb Dorsey for and in
 Consideration of the Sum of Forty two Pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain to him in hand Paid
 and Secured to be paid by him the said Uncle Unckles the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge
