

94) This Indenture made this sixteenth Day of November One thousand Seven hundred and fifty Between Uncle Unckles of Frederick County Planter on the one Part and Charles Carroll of the City of Annapolis Chyrurgeon on the other Part Witnesseth that Whereas Caleb Dorsey of Ann Arundel County hath of Equal Date with these Presents conveyed unto him the said Uncle Unckles all those four Tracts of Land Vizt Benjamin's Folly fifty Acres Harveys Brough fifty Acres Sparks Round fifty Acres Sparks Chance fifty Acres all lying in Prince Georges County as granted unto him the said Caleb Dorsey but now in Frederick County as by the Respective Patents of the said Tracts appear And Whereas further that a certain William Herley by his Deed of Bargain and Sale duly executed and Recorded in the Records of the said Frederick County conveyed unto him the said Uncle Unckles Two hundred and Nineteen Acres of Land being part of a Tract of Land called Cornwall Resurvey'd as by the said Deed bearing Date the first day of October One thousand Seven hundred and fifty may appear Now this Indenture further Witnesseth That the said Uncle Unckles for and in consideration of the sum of fortyfour Pounds Sterling Money of Great Brittain to him in hand Paid by him the said Charles Carroll the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge Hath given granted Bargained Sold Alien'd Enfeoffed and Confirmed And by these Presents Doth give Grant Bargain Sell Alien Enfeoffe and Confirm unto him the said Charles Carroll his Heirs and Assigns for ever all the afo. four Tracts of Land called Benjamin's Folly fifty Acres Harveys Brough fifty Acres Sparks Round fifty Acres Sparks Chance fifty Acres Containing in all Two hundred Acres of Land as by the Patents of them Respectively appear as also all that Two hundred and Nineteen Acres part of Cornwall Resurvey'd conveyed unto him the said Unckles by the afo. William Herley together with all the Buildings Improvements and Appurtenances on the said Several Tracts of Land being belonging or Appertaining To have and to hold unto him the said Charles Carroll his Heirs and Assigns for ever the said four Tracts of Land called Benjamin's Folly Fifty Acres Harveys Brough fifty Acres Sparks Chance fifty Acres Sparks Round fifty Acres Two hundred and Nineteen Acres part of Cornwall Resurvey'd together with their and every of their Appurtenances and the said Uncle Unckles Doth Covenant and agree with him the said Charles Carroll that he the said Charles Carroll his Heirs and Assigns for ever shall and may have hold Possess and Enjoy the said several Tracts of Land as well against him the said Uncle Unckles as against all manner of Persons or Claims whatsoever Provided always and the true intent and meaning of these Presents is such that in case the said Uncle Unckles shall Pay or cause to be Paid unto him the said Charles Carroll his Executors or Adm^{rs} at or upon the sixteenth Day of November which shall be in the Year of our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and fiftyone the afo. Sum of fortyfour Pounds Sterling Money of Great Brittain with the Lawfull Interest thereof then this Deed of Bargain and Sale to become Void and of no Effect In Witness whereof and the foregoing Premises the said Parties to these Presents have Interchangeably set their Hands and Affixed their Seals the Day and Year first above written
