The Condition of the above

Obligation is such that if the above bound Newell Locke, which he shall be and continue in the Office of Collector of the Excise in St. Marys County, shall well and faithfully Exercise & perform the several Duties required of him to be performed by the act of assembly Entituled, an Act for granting a supply of forty thousand pounds for his Majesty's service and striking thirty four thousand ^{and fifty} pounds ~~and~~ Six Shillings thereof in Bills of Credit, and raising a fund for sinking the same and do well and faithfully pay, to the Commissioners of the Loan Office for the time being, the several sums of money which he shall receive and be answerable for in Virtue of the same Act at such times as by the said Act is directed according to the true Intent and meaning thereof, then the above Obligation to be void and of no Effect, otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue.
