It is to be remembered that this Indenture made this twenty ninth Day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty seven between John Campbell of Ann Arundel County Taylor and Francis his Wife of the one part and James Johnson of the City of Annapolis in Ann Arundel County Merchant of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Campbell and Francis his Wife for and in Consideration of the sum of five Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to them in hand paid by the said James Johnson at or before the ensembling and Delivery of these presents, the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these Presents do bargain and sell unto the said James Johnson all that Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in Ann Arundel County called Blays necke containing two hundred Acres more or less and also all that Tract or Parcel of Land called Hornwoods Chance lying and being in Ann Arundel County containing three Hundred Acres of Land more or less, and also all that parcel of Land lying on the north Side of Severn River in Ann Arundel County at the Head of a creeke called Bueloos Creeke it being part of a Dividend called young Richard, beginning at an Oak and Cove called Poole Cove and so running from the said Oak north two hundred and fifty perches to a bounded Highway on the Top of a Hill it being a bounded Tract of the said young's Land and the
