Several Tracts or Parcels of Land and Premises with the  
Appurtenances hereby given granted released and confirmed  
or mentioned or intended to be hereby given granted released  
and confirmed unto the said James Johnson and his assigns for and  
During the natural Lives of the said John Campbell and Francis  
his Wife To the Intent and Purpose that the said James Johnson  
shall and may be perfect Tenant of the Freehold of all the said  
Lands and Premises with the appurtenances until one or  
more good and Perfect Recovery or Recoveries may be had  
against him the said James Johnson of the same Lands and
