William Cromwell for and in consideration of the sum of Three
Shillings Current Money to him in hand paid by the said
Nathan Hughes at or before the Sealing and Delivery of
these Presents the Recoit whereof he doth truly Acknowledge
and the said Nathan Hughes his Executors Administrators
and assigns doth thereto Acquit and Discharge, He doth grant
bargained and sold by these Presents Doth grant bargain
and sell unto him the said Nathan Hughes his Executors
Administrators and assigns all that Tract or Parcel of Land
Called Bear Neck Lying and being in Ann Arundel County
aforesaid containing One hundred and forty Acres and the
Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Heres
Issues and Profits thereof and of every part and Parcel
thereof To have and to hold the aforesaid Tract or Parcel of Land
and Premises with the appurtenances unto him the said Nathan
Hughes his Executors Administrators and assigns from the
Day next before the Day of the Date of these Presents until
