of Land by a Deedway thereon wherby Richard Bennetts Esq^r
Deceased United and Consolidated into One Tract of Land called Bennetts
Grove and by his the Said Richard Bennetts Last will and
Testament devised unto Eleanor Darnall and Elizabeth Darnall
Daughters of Henry Darnall of Portland mannor to them and
the Heirs of their Bodys to be equally divided between them and
the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents
Issues and Profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof
To have and to hold the aforesaid Tracts or Parcels of
Land and Premises with the appurtenances unto him
