 assigns and the said Henry Keene for my self my Exor Adm^r &
 assigns and agree to and with the said Laurance Owen his Exor Adm^r
 and assigns to Warrant and Defend the said hereby bargained and
 sold Premises unto the said Laurance Owen his Exor Adm^r and
 assigns agt me the said Henry Keene and all other Person or
 Persons whatsoever Provided nevertheless and it is the true Intent
 and meaning of these presents that if the said Henry Keene his
 Exor or Adm^r do & shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid
 unto the said Laurance Owen his Exor Adm^r or assigns the said
 sum of one hundred Pounds thirteen Shillings Current Money
 on or before the Eighth Day of March next ensuing with Legal
 Interest for the Same from the Date hereof that then this present
 Instrument of writing shall be void & of none Effect otherwise to
 remain in full force and Virtue in Law In Witness whereof
 said Henry Keene have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this
 18th day of August in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred
 and fifty six
