and Administrators for and in the whole firmly by these presents
Sealed with my Seal and dated this ~~twenty~~ 2^d day of October Anno
Domini 1757

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the
above bound Thomas Lingan do and shall well and truly
pay or cause to be paid to the said James Macculbin his certain
Attorney Executors Administrators or assigns the just and full
sum of One hundred and ten pounds Sterling money of
Great Britain at upon the 10th day of Nov. next Ensuing the
Date hereof, with Legal Interest for the same then the above
(Oblig.)
