October in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and fifty
Seven Between Thomas Lingam of Baltimore County
Physician of the one part, and James Macculbin of the
City of Annapolis Merchant of the other part. Whereas
the said Thomas Lingam by his Writing Obligatory bearing
the same date with these presents acknowledged himself
to be held and firmly bound unto James Macculbin
aforesaid in the penal sum of Two hundred and twelve
pounds Sterling with Condition there under Written to be
Void on the Payment of the sum of One hundred and
six pounds Sterling money of great Britain as by the
said Writing Obligatory may more fully appear Now this
Indenture witnesseth that the said Thomas Lingam
as well for the better securing the payment of the principal
money and Interest due by the said Bond as for and in
consideration of the sum of five Shillings Sterling money
by the said James Macculbin to the said Lingam in hand
paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
