The Conditions of the above Obligation, is such that if the above bound Thomas Contee, whilst he shall be and Continue in the office of Collector of the Excise in Prince Georges County, shall well and faithfully exercise and performe the severall Duties Required of him to be performed by the act of Assembly entitled an act for granting a supply of Forty thousand pounds for his Majesty's service and striking Forty four thousand and fifteen pounds Sixpence Shillings thereof in bills of Credit and raising of and for sinking the same, and do well and faithfully pay to the Commissioners of the Loan Office for the time being the severall Sums of money which he shall receive, and be answerable for, in virtue of the same act at such time as by the said Act is directed, according to the true Intent and meaning thereof; then the above obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full Force and Virtue.
