year first above written.

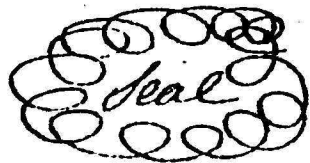

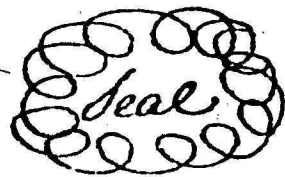
