The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the
above bound Colmore Beanes, whilst he shall be and continue
in the Office of Collector of the Excise in Prince Georges County
shall well and faithfully Exercise and Perform the several
Duties required of him to be performed by the Act of
Assembly Entituled an Act for granting a supply of forty
thousand pounds for his Majesty's Service and striking
