a^s. Gent are held and firmly Bound unto the Right Hon. the Lord
Proprietor his Heirs and Successors in the full and just Sum of Two
Hundred Pounds Current Money of the Province a^s. to be paid to
the Said Lord Proprietor his Heirs and Successors which Payment
well & Truly to be made and done We do hereby bind ourselves our
Heirs Executors and Administrators & Every of them Jointly &
Severally for the whole and in the whole family by these Presents
Seal with our Seals and Dated this 18. Day of October 1756

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that if the
above Bounden Charles Dickinson whilst he shall continue
in the office of Receiver or Collector of the Land Tax in Dorchester
County shall well and faithfully Execute and Perform the several
duties Require of him to be Performed by the Act of Assembly
of this Province Entituled an act for granting a supply of Forty
thousand Pounds for his Majestys Service and trusting thirty
four thousand and fifteen Pounds six Shillings thereof in Bills
of Credit and Raising a Sum for sinking the Same and do
well and faithfully Pay to the Commissioners of the Loan Office
for the time being the Several Sums of money which he shall
(Receive)
