The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Hall Laile whilst he shall be and continue in the Office of Collector of the Excise, in Dorchester County shall well and faithfully exercise, and perform the several Duties required of him to be performed by the Act of Assembly Entituled an Act for granting a supply of thirty thousand pounds for his Majesty's service and striking thirty four thousand and fifteen pounds, six shillings, thereof in Bills of Credit, and raising a Fund for sinking the same, and do well and faithfully pay to the Commissioners of the Loan Office for the Time being the
