Collector of the said Tax in Baltimore County shall well and faithfully
execute and perform the several duties required of him to be performed
by the act of Assembly of this Province entitled "An act for granting
a supply of Forty thousand Pounds for his Majesty's Service and
striking Thirty four thousand and fifteen pounds Six shillings
thereof in Bills of Credit and raising a Fund for sinking the
