Charles Carroll all that Tract or Parcel of Land called William  
and Elizabeth's Fancy lying in Baltimore County Joining to  
Coles Caves Granted unto a certain William Little for one  
hundred Acres with all the Right Title Interest and Claim  
either in Law or equity to the same together with its Appurte-  
nances To Have and to Hold unto him the said Charles  
Carroll his Heirs and Assigns for Ever all the said Tract or  
Parcel of Land called William and Elizabeth's Fancy with its  
Appurtenances And the said John Little doth Covenant and  
agree to and with him the said Charles Carroll that he the
