Maryland^s This Indenture made the twenty first Day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and fifty Six Between Charles Hornwood of Annesburrough County in the Province aforesaid Gentleman and John Price of the City of Annapolis in the Province aforesaid Esquire of the one Part and Thomas Jennings of the City aforesaid Gentleman of the other Part Witnesseth that the Said Charles Hornwood and John Price for and in Consideration of the Sum of five Shillings of Lawfull money of Great Brittain to them in hand Paid by the Said Thomas Jennings at or before enseatling and Deliber of those Presents the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged have bargained and Sold by those Presents do bargain and Sell unto the Thomas Jennings all that Part of a Tract of Land called Sea Land containing two hundred acres more or Less with the Appurtenances Lying in the County aforesaid together with the Houses buildings Improvements Commodities and advantages to the same belonging To have and to Hold the Said Part or Parcel of Land and Premises with the appurtenances hereby bargained and Sold or mentioned or intended to be hereby bargained and Sold unto the Said Thomas Jennings his Executors Administrators and assigns from the Day next before the Day of the Date of these Presents for during and unto the full End and Term of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be (Completed)
