This Indenture Tripartite made this Ninth day of March in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and fifty nine Between Samuel Chew of Herring Bay in Annaprindel County Gentleman of the first Part Thomas Lane Weems of Annaprindel County Gentleman of the second Part and Bennett Chew of Annaprindel County Gentleman of the third Part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Chew for and in Consideration of the sum of Five Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to him in Hand paid by the said Thomas Lane Weems at or before the Ensealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted released and confirmed and by these Presents doth give Grant Release and confirm unto the said Thomas Lane Weems one undivided Moiety of all that Tract or Parcel of Plantable Land called Hall's Choice with the Appurtenances lying and being in Cecil County containing four hundred Acres and also one undivided Moiety of all that Tract or Parcel of Plantable Land called Hall's Lott with the Appurtenances lying and being in Cecil County containing six hundred Acres late in the Tenure or Occupation of the said Samuel Chew / But now all in the Actual Possession of the said Thomas Lane Weems by force of an Indenture of bargain and sale thereof made bearing Date the Day before the date of these Presents and of the Statute for Transferring of Uses into Possession being / To have and to hold the said several undivided Moieties of the aforesaid Tracts or Parcels of Plantable Land with the Appurtenances hereby given granted released and confirmed or mentioned or intended to be hereby given granted released and confirmed unto the said Thomas Lane Weems and his Assigns
