 And that whereas the said George Ellis by his Deeds of Lease and Release

 thousand seven hundred and five did for the Consideration therein
 mentioned grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto him and
 his heirs the said Tract of Land called Infield Chase and other the Lands
 therein after specified ^{for the Consideration} of the sum of four hundred pounds Sterling being
 the Consideration of the said Ellis's Deed to him, in hand paid by the said
 Charles Carroll did grant and confirm unto the said Charles Carroll
