This Indenture made the 30th day of May Seventeen hundred and
fifty nine Between Mary Wilson of Kent County in the Province
of Maryland widow of the one part and James Wilson of the
Same County Planter of the Other part Witnesseth that the said
Mary Wilson as well for the natural Love and affection which
she beareth unto the said James Wilson as for and in Considera-
tion of the sum of five Shillings Sterling money to her in
hand paid the receipt whereof she the said Mary Wilson
doth hereby acknowledge and her self therewith fully satisfied
contented and paid hath granted Bargained and Sold released
and confirmed and by these presents doth fully freely and absolutely
grant Bargain and Sell Release and confirm unto the said
James Wilson his heirs and assigns forever all the Right
Title Interest Claim and demand whatsoever which she the
said Mary Wilson now has or hereafter may have to one
hundred acres of Land called deemed and taken for part of
Verina Being the Land & plantation whereon the said James
Wilson now dwelle Situate lying and being in Kent County
aforesaid Seventy acres thereof being the Land that his Grand
Father James Wilson gave to John Wilson by deed of gift bearing
date the 20th day of April 1726 and the other thirty acres being
the Land that was made over to him by George Wilson with
all houses Buildings Gardens orchards fences and improvements
Whatsoever to the said Mesuage or Tenement belonging or in
any way appertaining and of every part and parcel thereof
with the appurtenances and also all the Estate Right Title
Interest Claim and demand whatsoever as well in Equity as
in Law of her - the said Mary Wilson of in and to all
